# Getting There

## How to get to Central Coast Grammar School

CCGS

**1** Take F3 Freeway North and exit left at the Gosford exit (which is approx. 1.5km after you have driven over the Mooney Mooney Bridge) and join the Central Coast Highway at Kariong.

**2** Drive down Kariong Mountain through West Gosford and over Brian McGowan Bridge into Gosford. Then, at small roundabout at base of bridge, turn right along water's edge and continue along road following all signs that say to "The Entrance" for approx. 9km.

**3** After going through East Gosford and Erina you will approach a major intersection with traffic lights at the junction of the Central Coast Highway and Terrigal Drive. Proceed straight ahead at these traffic lights and stay on the Central Coast Highway for a further 1km. There is one more small roundabout at the corner of Carlton Rd and the Central Coast Highway - continue up the hill and stay on the Central Coast Highway.

**4** Turn left into Arundel Road. Take a sharp left into the Visitors Carpark and follow the signs to Administration or turn right into the Performing Arts Centre and Senior College Administration Carpark.
